Charlotte Mandel will read and discuss her poem-novella *The Marriages of Jacob*. Ms. Mandel is a poet, editor, teacher and independent scholar who has published seven books of poetry. Her poetry, short fiction and critical essays have appeared in journals nationwide. She has given readings and presentations at the Folger Shakespeare Library; Manhattan Theatre Club; Yale University; University of Goteborg, Sweden; and the Geraldine R. Dodge Poetry Festival, among many others. She recently retired from teaching

poetry writing at Barnard College Center for Research on Women.

The Marriages of Jacob is a rich tapestry of biblical lore coming alive in fine, vigorous language. Erotic and sensual in parts, it has been described as lyric, substantial, and authentic, feeling sacred through and through, although with no sense of piety.
